Mission Statement: Good News Homes is a faith-based organization that exists to help displaced or at-risk families, especially those who are underserved, find housing and / or related resources that can help them become or stay self-sufficient.

Vision Statement: Good News Homes' vision is of that day when the Oldham-Trimble area provides safe, decent housing for all persons residing there.

In the past year, Good News Shelter has:

1. Provided permanent housing to three families through the RoseHaven II program and Wiano program which included three adults and three children.
2. Provided transitional housing to 18 families through the Bedford apartments, Smith House and RoseHaven which included 19 adults and 23 children.
3. Provided Rapid Rehousing (street to permanent housing through landlords in community) for 16 families which includes 19 adults and 16 children. These families were housed in available units throughout Oldham, Henry and Trimble counties.
4. Provided emergency services through United Charities in Henry and Trimble counties through hotel or one-time rent payments for nine families which included ten children and twelve adults.
5. Provided emergency services through Metro United Way in Oldham county through hotel or one-time rent payments for twelve families.
6. Received over 348 requests for housing in 2018 from Oldham, Trimble, Jefferson, and Henry counties.
